- service line extensions

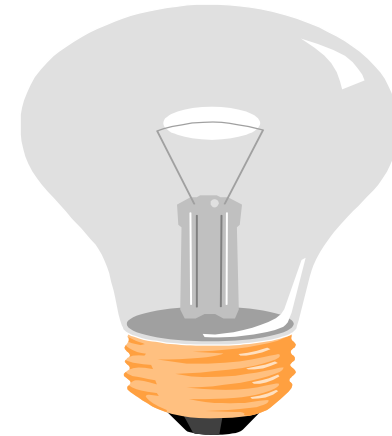
**NEW SERVICE OR UPGRADING COSTS**

Basic overhead (200amp or less)	\$250.00	
Basic underground (200amp or less)	\$750.00	
Temporary Service	\$100.00	
Three Phase (overhead or underground)		at cost
Dip Service (from pole to underground)		at cost
New development requiring transformer & all related materials (all service sizes)		at cost

**ACCESS TO PREMISES**

- City of Grand Forks employees shall have the right of safe and unobstructed access to the customer's premises for the purpose of making connections, disconnections, meter readings, checking City property and carrying out electrical utility duties as required.
- If access to the property is deemed unsafe due to obstruction by a vicious animal or access to meter is not possible or customer requests a meter check, and a return trip is required, there will be a \$50.00 service charge for the return trip.
- City has authority to enter property and inspect hazardous trees or any other growth which may impede the electrical service.

**Effective January 01, 2001**

Residential electrical utility rates  
are **\$0.05565 per KWH**  
Basic minimum charge per month for residential  
**\$9.90**

Commercial electrical utility rates  
are **\$0.07970 per KWH**  
Basic minimum charge per month for commercial/industrial/  
institutional  
**\$19.75**

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Application for services, for reading meters, turning meter on  
or reconnection of meter, fee shall be  
**\$28.89**  
(including gst)

Each additional meter at same location  
**\$10.70**  
(including gst)

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The Freedom of Information Act restricts the City from  
informing the property owner of the status of their tenants  
accounts . To alleviate this problem in the future,

**Beginning January 01, 1999**

**All electrical accounts shall be the responsibility of the  
PROPERTY OWNER.**

**Property owner may arrange to have their electrical bills  
sent directly to their tenant who will become their  
authorized agent.**

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**ELECTRICAL UTILITY BILLING SCHEDULE**

Utility bills will be issued on a bi-monthly basis  
(February, April, June, August, October, December)  
and are due upon receipt

eg: January/February bill due last working day in March  
March/April bill due last working day in May,

**Effective January 01, 1999**

2% penalty per month will apply to accounts not paid by the due  
date

Amounts outstanding in arrears after December 31st  
shall be transferred to taxes and bear interest from date of transfer

**EQUAL PAYMENT PLAN**

Equal payments as calculated from previous year's  
consumption can be made by authorizing automatic  
withdrawal from customer's account. Customer's may  
make application any time during the year. 2% per  
month penalty does not apply to accounts on the equal  
payment plan.

A Customer will qualify for the plan provided the  
account is not in arrears and the Customer expects to be  
on the plan for at least one year.
